

# Although, Even Though

## Although or Even Though to contrast

Although can go at the beginning or in the middle of a sentence.

When it goes at the beginning, we use a comma between the ideas.

Example: **Although** she had a cold, she went to work.

When we use although in the middle of a sentence, the comma is not necessary.

Example: She went to work **although** she had a cold.
