#### A. GRAMMAR - COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES (So sánh hơn với tính từ):

- **Cách dùng:** So sánh hơn thường được sử dụng cho việc **so sánh 2 hay nhiều vật/người với nhau**.

- **Cấu trúc:**

S1 + to be + **short adj-er** + **than** + S2.

Bikes are **slower than** cars.

(Xe đạp chậm hơn xe ô tô.)

S1 + to be + **more + long adj** + **than** + S2.

A lion is **more dangerous than** an elephant.

(Sư tử nguy hiểm hơn voi.)

Note: S: chủ ngữ, adj = adjective: tính từ

#### \* Lưu ý 1:

- **Short adj** (Tính từ ngắn) là các tính từ có **một âm tiết**. (tall, short, big, small, old, young, ...)

- **Long adj** (Tính từ dài) là tính từ có từ **2 âm tiết trở lên**. (intelligent, beautiful, expensive, interesting, ...)

#### \* Lưu ý 2:

1. Tính từ hai âm tiết tận cùng bằng <b>-er, -le, -ow, -et</b> thì coi là tính từ ngắn.	simple – simpler narrow – narrower
2. Tính từ có đuôi <b>-y</b> , chuyển <b>-y</b> thành <b>-i</b> rồi thêm <b>-er</b> .	dirty – dirtier happy – happier
3. Với tính từ ngắn, nếu trước phụ âm cuối là một nguyên âm thì gấp đôi phụ âm cuối.	big – bigger sad – sadder




