Dodo


A large animal lived in prehistoric times that lived on the ground rather than in trees.

Sabre-toothed squirrel



This is an animal had enormous tusks and lived in the past.





Could	Use could and couldn't for ability in the past	Affirmative (+)	Eg: <u>When I was younger, I could</u> run a mile in 7 minutes. But now it takes me 20 minutes.
Couldn't (Could not)		Negative (-)	Eg: <u>Yesterday, I couldn't find</u> my wallet anywhere. But this morning I found it.
