## Adjective Order

Determiner	Quantity (number)	Quality (opinion)	Size	Age	Shape	Color	Origin	Material	Noun
A/An/The	three	good	small	new	round	blue	Italian	golden	necklace

### EXAMPLE

- My father bought **a wonderful old Italian** clock. ( *determiner - opinion-age-material* )
- I need **two soft cotton** blankets. ( *number-opinion-material* )
