7. _____: A shop primarily selling newspapers, magazines, tobacco products, and sometimes snacks or lottery tickets. It typically focuses on printed media.

9. _____: A store where equipment and clothing for sports activities are sold, such as items for soccer, tennis, running, or gym training. Some may also offer specialized gear for different sports.
