Like + gerund

Affirmative and negative sentences

You	like	collecting stamps.
We	don't like	playing the drums.
They		talking to friends
He	likes	going to concerts.
She	doesn't like	making things.

Remember! When a short verb ends with a consonant, a vowel and a consonant, we double the final consonant.
