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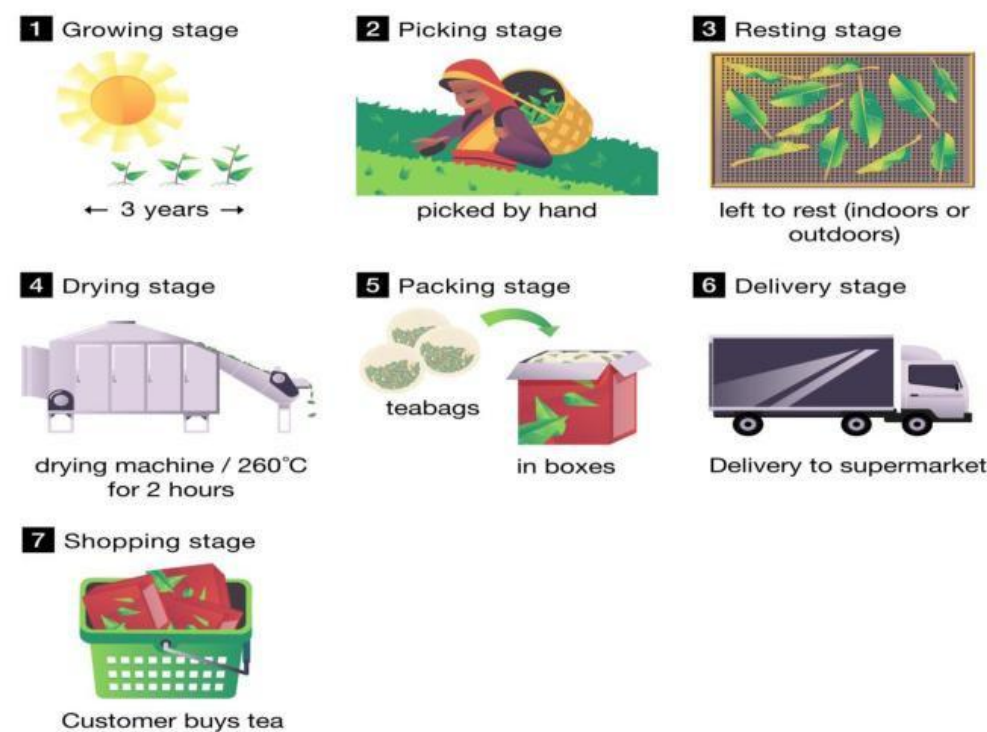

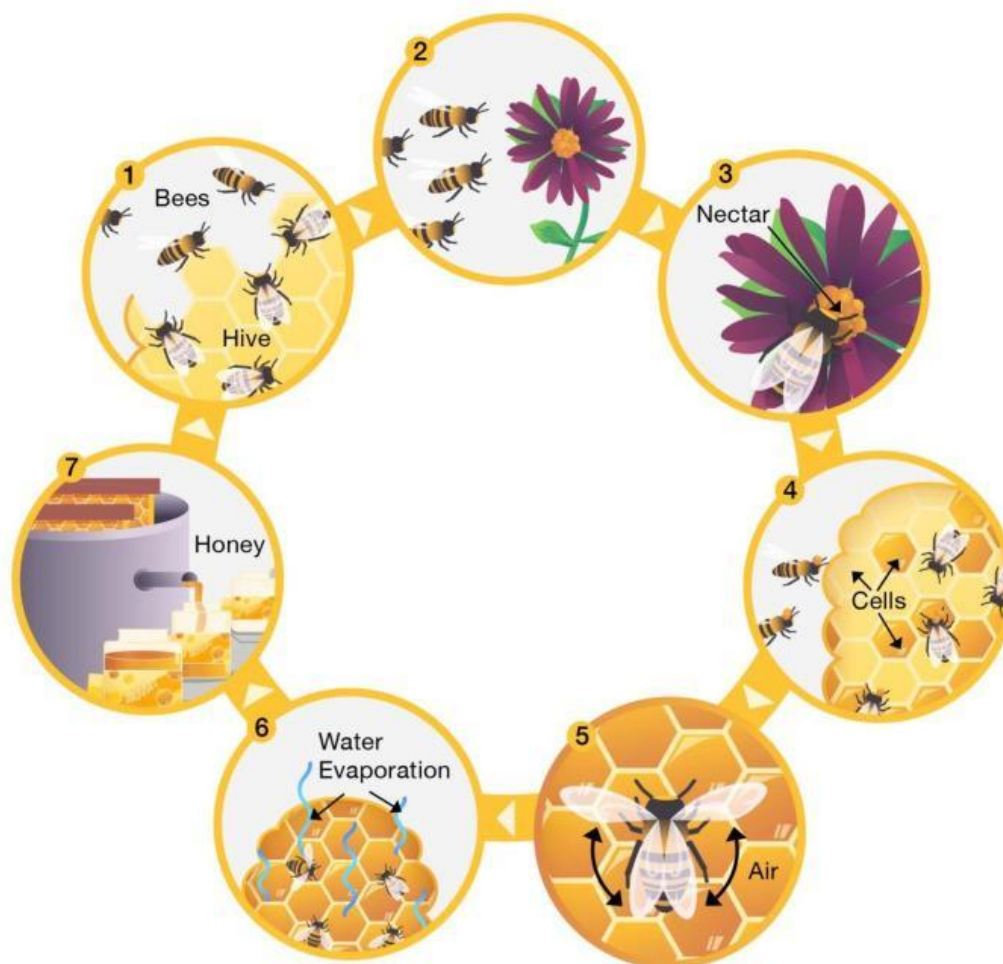
1. First of all, the tea is grown for three years.

6. The boxes are then packed into lorries. The lorries deliver the tea to the supermarkets.
7. Finally, customers buy the tea when they are shopping.
