#### A. GRAMMAR

##### Second conditional with UNLESS / I WISH / IF ONLY

Ta có thể dùng **I wish / if only** để diễn đạt mong ước về một điều không có thật hoặc không thể thực hiện được trong hiện tại.

**If only** sẽ chỉ sắc thái mạnh hơn **I wish**.

#### Second conditional with UNLESS / I WISH / IF ONLY

Ta có thể sử dụng **unless** thay cho **if not** trong câu điều kiện loại 2.

I wouldn't stay here if I **did not have** a car.  
--> I wouldn't stay here **unless** I had a car.

|---------------------------------------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| <b>S + wish(es) + (that) + S + Past simple.</b>   | I wish (that) I <b>didn't need</b> to work today.                                                       |
| <b>S + wish(es) + (that) + S + could + V-inf.</b> | I wish (that) I <b>could study</b> harder at school.                                                    |
| <b>If only + S + Past simple.</b>                 | <b>If only</b> I <b>studied</b> harder at school.<br><b>If only</b> I <b>didn't need</b> to work today. |

##### \*Lưu ý:

• Chúng ta thường dùng “**could**” thay vì “**would**” để diễn đạt mong ước về hiện tại. Tuy nhiên, “**would**” có thể được dùng trong trường hợp người nói hiện tại cảm thấy khó chịu về hành vi của người khác hoặc một tình huống ngoài tầm kiểm soát của mình.

**Ex:** I wish you **would** stop making so much noise. (You are making noise; it would be better if you didn't.)

• “**Were**” có thể được dùng thay cho “**was**” (**I, he, she, it, danh từ số ít + was/ were**), nhất là trong **lời văn trang trọng**.

**Ex:** I wish I **was/ were** taller, I might be better at basketball.
