<b>Producer</b>	Writes the script, which may be an original work or an adaptation of existing material.
<b>Director</b>	Responsible for the creative vision of the film, directing actors and coordinating the overall production process.
<b>Screenwriter</b>	Assembles the filmed footage into a coherent final product, working closely with the director.
<b>Script Supervisor</b>	Oversees the entire production, including securing financing, hiring key staff, and managing the budget.
<b>Director of Photography (DoP)</b>	Operates the camera under the direction of the DoP.
<b>Camera Operator</b>	Oversees the creation and integration of visual effects during post-production
<b>Set Designer</b>	Oversees the visual aspects of the film, including camera work and lighting.
<b>Composer</b>	Works under the production designer to create the physical environment for the film.
<b>Editor</b>	Creates the musical score that accompanies the film.
<b>Visual Effects Supervisor:</b>	Ensures continuity by keeping track of what has been filmed and noting any deviations from the script.
