1. Found in the Pir Panjal Range of the Himalayas, its name means 'meadow of flowers'.
2. The only hill station in India's largest state, located in the Aravalli Range.
3. Known for its tea plantations, found in the deep south of the Western Ghats.
4. Nestled in the Himalayas, you can see the majestic Kanchenjunga from here.
5. The name of this hill station, in the Kumaon Hills, is a combination of the words for eye and lake.
6. A pedestrian-only hill station in the Sahyadri mountain range.
7. A hill station in the Shivalik Range, that gives the state its tourism logo—the peafowl.
8. In the heart of India, called the Queen of the Satpuras.
9. The only hill station in India's westernmost state.
10. Also known as Mercara, found in the southern part of the Western Ghats.
11. Known as the Queen of the Nilgiris.
12. Further uphill from Kullu, found in the abode of snow.



Hill Stations : Saputara, Ooty, Nainital, Madikeri, Pachmarhi, Morni Hills, Munnar, Manali, Mount Abu, Matheran, Gulmarg, Darjeeling.

States/UTS : Karnataka, Haryana, Rajasthan, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Gujarat.
