Ethernet cable, RJ45 connectors, Crimping tool, Network cable tester, Cable cutter

1. Make sure the cable is the correct length before starting.
2. Use the cable cutter to strip about 1 inch of the cable insulation from both ends.
3. Arrange the colored wires inside the cable according to the T568B wiring standard.
4. Insert the wires into the RJ45 connector and use the crimping tool to secure them.
5. Repeat the process for the other end of the cable.
6. Test the cable with a network cable tester to ensure proper connectivity.
