

## Sentence or Fragment?

sentence = 1 complete idea

complete = has at least 2 parts: someone/thing AND do/be

fragment = broken piece

sentence fragment = broken piece of a sentence

sentence fragment = missing someone or something OR do or be

These are fragments.
