Philips Academy's Summer Camp

Philips Academy is a boarding school that focuses on empowering students and offers academic excellence. It has 300 courses in 18 subject areas. There has a large, dedicated academic staff. In fact, there is a teacher for every five students. During the academic school year, it is home to 800 high school students from 30 different countries.

However, during the long school holidays, the school organises a summer camp. This year, the camp is between 6 July and 8 August. It is open to students aged 13 to 18 years old. Applicants have to apply by 5 May. There is an application fee of US\$70 and the tuition fee for the 5-week camp is US\$5500.

The application process also requires interested students to write a one to two-page essay. They should write about their interests and abilities, share one important person, incident or experience that has made an impact in their life and explain why they want to attend the camp.

The three main programmes organised cover sports, community and music. The sports programme promotes fitness, sportsmanship and learning new skills. The community programme has on-campus activities such as educational films, seminars and off-campus field trips to theme parks, beaches and going on hikes. For the music portion of the programme, students can join vocal or musical groups.
