Port Dickson Army Museum

Port Dickson is an army town that houses various army institutions and training centres. One main attraction there is the Port Dickson Army Museum, known as Muzium Tentera Darat. This museum is managed by the Malaysian Royal Armed Forces. Opened in 2005, the museum serves a dual purpose: to preserve the stories of Malaysia's brave soldiers and to educate visitors about the country's military capabilities.

The Port Dickson Army Museum is located in two original buildings from the Basic Army Training Centre (PUSASDA). The idea of an army museum was inspired by General Tan Sri Md Hashim when he was the Army Commander in 1999. It consists of nine galleries and various outdoor exhibits, including military aircraft, helicopters, steam trains, armoured vehicles and artillery pieces. As visitors step into the museum area, they can hear the ambient sounds of plane propellers and see the display of decommissioned military vehicles, creating a captivating atmosphere.

The galleries are arranged chronologically, covering the history of the armed forces, the colonial era, the Malay Regiment, the Japanese occupation and the modern-day army of Malaysia today. Visitors will get to see a wide range of artefacts such as uniforms, medals, weapons and documents. There is also a recreation of a Communist tunnel network from the Emergency period that runs beneath the museum.

Notably, the Port Dickson Army Museum won the Merit Award in the category of 'Best Tourist Attraction on National Identity (Heritage) 2005/2006' awarded by Tourism Malaysia. Entrance is free and visitors can come to visit from Wednesdays to Sundays from 10.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. Additionally, guided tours can be arranged with army personnel for larger groups, offering a comprehensive and engaging experience for visitors.
