Life of Pi

The book, *Life of Pi* was written by Yann Martel, a Canadian author who won the Man Booker Prize for this novel. The novel is an adventure fiction and a must-read for young people.

Life of Pi is about Pi Patel, the sixteen-year-old son of a zookeeper from Pondicherry, India. It starts with Pi and his family on their journey to Canada to settle there. However, during their journey, the ship they are on encounters a terrible storm and sinks. Pi is the only human survivor and manages to escape in a small lifeboat. He soon realises that his only companions are a wounded zebra, a spotted hyena, a seasick orang utan and a Bengal tiger called Richard Parker.

The hungry hyena kills the zebra and then the orang utan. Then, the Bengal tiger kills and eats the hyena. And so, only Pi and the Bengal tiger are left to fend for themselves for 227 days, adrift in the Pacific Ocean. Pi learns to fight for survival and eventually becomes the tiger's master. The lifeboat finally washes up onto a beach in Mexico. Richard Parker escapes into the nearby jungle and disappears while Pi is rescued.

In 2012, *Life of Pi* was adapted into a feature film. The film was directed by Ang Lee, with the screenplay by David Magee. The movie was released in the United States on 21 November, 2012. At the 85th Academy Awards, it won four awards out of eleven nominations including the award for Best Director.
