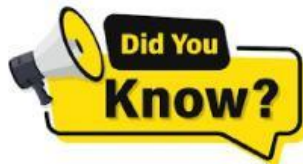
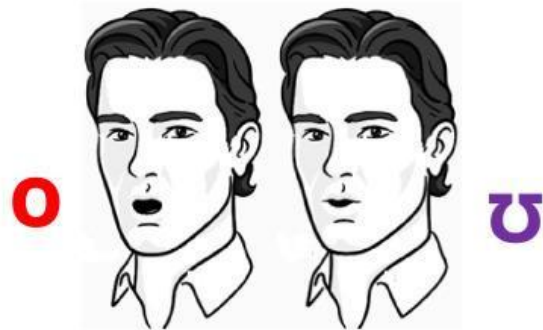

describing leisure activities
using the gerund

- We use **go +ing** for activities we do for fun in our free time.
- **Go +ing** indicates the whole activity and experience, not just the action expressed by the verb.
- This structure is used with verbs that are **not** followed by an object.
- The verb "go" changes based on the verb tense we use, for example:
He **goes** running every day after work.
We **are going** kayaking this weekend.
I **went** shopping yesterday.

go sailing
go camping
go sightseeing
go jogging
go skiing
go kayaking
go dancing
go trekking
go skating
go fishing
go scuba diving
go mountain climbing

I like to **go jogging** in the mornings.

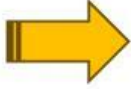
