


APTIS EXAM - TASK 2 - DESCRIBING A PICTURE

1. Use the following expressions to describe the picture:

(**people, place, objects, situation**)

Describe relevant general/specific actions (situation):

Use **BE+V-ing** to describe people's actions (now)

Use **V(base form)** to connect to people's habits
(**give details, examples, explanations**)

2. Talk about a memory, a personal experience, or something/someone you know about.
Give as many **details** as possible.
3. Talk about people's traditions and general customs.
Give **examples, reasons, and explanations**.
