



We use reflexive pronouns when we want to refer back to a person or a thing. The reflexive pronoun is used as a direct object when the object of the sentence is the same as the subject of the verb.



Example: I'm so proud of **myself** for passing my exams.

Personal Pronouns	Reflexive Pronouns
I	myself
you	yourself
he	himself
she	herself
they	themselves
we	ourselves
it	itself
you (plural)	yourselves

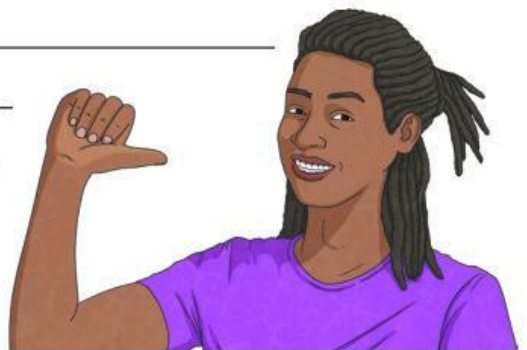
