

PART I - LISTENING

Example:

Girl: Dad! Come and look at my photos.

Number 2:

Dad: Who's the girl with long brown hair? Look, she's sitting next to the bookcase.

Girl: That's Katy. She won the school art 4. last year – she loves art.

Girl: Can you see my friend Helen? She's talking to my teacher.

Dad: No. Where is she?

Girl: She's there, near the door.

Dad: Oh. Is she wearing 5.?

Girl: No, she's the one with curly hair.

Number 3:

Dad: Where's your friend, Sarah, then?

Girl: Oh, she's getting some more 6. from the teacher's desk.

Dad: Is that her with the pink skirt?

Girl: No, she's standing next to that girl. She's wearing green 7. They're going to do some drawing, I think.

Number 4:

Girl: Can you see my friend Helen? She's talking to my teacher.

Dad: No. Where is she?

Girl: She's there, 8. the door.

Dad: Oh. Is she wearing glasses?

Girl: No, she's the one with 9. hair.

Number 5:

Dad: Who's the boy over there? Look, he's looking for something under the table.

Girl: Oh, that's Harry.

Dad: What's he 10. for?

Girl: I think he dropped (làm rớt) his pencil.

PART II - LISTENING

Example:

Female: Oh hello, George. Can I ask you some questions?

Male: Yes, of course, Holly. What about?

Female: The guitar 11. which your son has. My daughter would like to learn the guitar.
