20 Tanya : These cakes are great. Oh, I'm thirsty too.

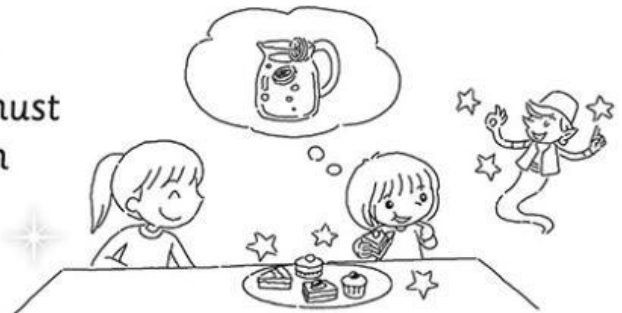
Joe : Abracadabra! Let's all drink this juice!
