





The Camel

What is special about the camel? Well, first of all, camels have humps. Some of them have one hump and some have two. The Arabian one-humped camel came originally from the Middle East; the two-humped Bactrian camel was originally from the dry parts of Asia. Camels are the largest animals in the desert. Camels are common in zoos around the world, but today they're rare in the wild. They are between 2.25 and 3.45 metres long, and they are up to 2.1 metres tall. Arabian camels have longer legs, but they aren't as heavy as Bactrian camels.

Camels have got thick fur. This protects them against the hot days and cold nights of the desert. Their huge feet, with only two toes, are ideal for walking on sand, and they can close their noses when they are in a sandstorm.

There isn't a lot of water in the desert, so how do camels survive? Camels have a solution for this problem. They don't need to drink for long periods of time because they can store water in their humps. They just drink a lot before a long journey! In fact, camels can drink more than 50 litres of water in a short time. They store this water, and their food, in their humps.
