The Edinburgh International Book Festival

The Edinburgh International Book Festival was founded in 1983. At that time, it consisted of only several events centred on meeting authors. Now, it organises hundreds of events during the festival period. The festival lasts several days at the end of August. It has always been held at the

Charlotte Square but in 2021, it moved to a new, permanent location at the University of Edinburgh Futures Institute. This year, it is going to be held from 10 to 25 August.

The festival organises events for adults, teenagers and children. Avid readers can meet award-winning and new writers when they attend various creative writing workshops, book signings and talks. In addition, through the Children's Programme, young people can learn and be entertained on subjects such as art, history and astronomy. Furthermore, at the Writer's Retreat, attendees can listen to authors talk about their books. Another exciting event is the First Book Award which is a competition for new writers. Here, attendees can learn about the works of new writers. Besides authors, illustrators, poets, musicians, historians and philosophers are also going to participate in the festival.

Attendees can also attend performances by poets and musicians. In addition, they can visit the festival's bookshop which offers a wide variety of books for children and adults.
