Let's Change to Renewable Energy

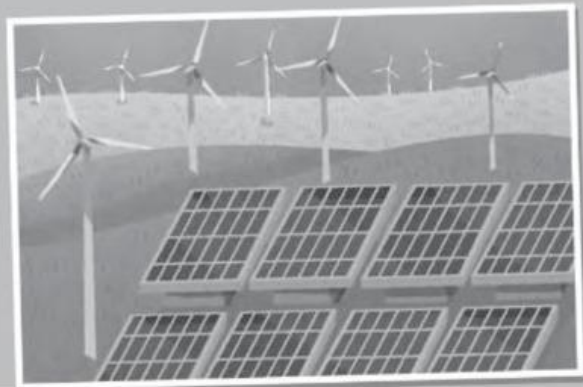
