Domineer (Verb)	To rule or control someone in a harsh or bossy way.	The older brother tried to domineer his younger siblings, making them do all his chores.
Tyranny (Noun)	Cruel and oppressive government or rule.	The people suffered under the tyranny of the king, who took away their rights and freedoms.
Consequences (Noun)	The results or effects of an action or decision.	The consequences of not studying for the test were a failing grade and a lot of stress.
Fathom (Verb)	To understand or figure out something completely.	It was hard to fathom why she would say such a hurtful thing to her friend.
Suffocation (Noun)	The feeling of being unable to breathe properly, often caused by lack of air.	The smoke from the fire caused a feeling of suffocation in the room.
Inevitable (Adjective)	Something that is certain to happen and cannot be avoided.	The storm was inevitable , and everyone knew it was coming.
Reluctant (Adjective)	Hesitant or unwilling to do something.	He was reluctant to go to the party because he didn't know anyone there.
Dreadful (Adjective)	Very bad or unpleasant.	The food at the restaurant was dreadful , and we all left hungry.
Inauspicious (Adjective)	Suggesting that something bad is likely to happen.	The dark clouds and strong winds were inauspicious signs for the picnic.
Vehemence (Noun)	Strong feeling or passion, especially when expressing anger or disagreement.	He argued with great vehemence , slamming his fist on the table.
