A. GRAMMAR

I. Present simple passive (Câu bị động thì hiện tại đơn)

(+)	S + am/is/are + V (P.P) + (by O). <i>Ex: The heavy boxes are carried by James.</i>
(-)	S + am/is/are + not + V (P.P) + (by O). <i>Ex: Global warming isn't properly addressed in the documentary.</i>
(?)	Am/Is/Are + S + V (P.P) + (by O)? <i>Ex: Is the rabbit walked by Mr. James?</i> Wh-word + am/is/are + S + V (P.P) + (by O)? <i>Ex: Where is the party held by your friend?</i>

II. Past simple passive (Câu bị động thì quá khứ đơn)

(+)	S + was/were + V (P.P) + (by O). <i>Ex: The mistakes were corrected by the teacher.</i>
(-)	S + was/were + not + V (P.P) + (by O). <i>Ex: The wallet was not given by him.</i>
(?)	Was/Were + S + V (P.P) + (by O)? <i>Ex: Were all the candies sold by the little boy?</i> Wh- word + was/were + S + V (P.P) + (by O)? <i>Ex: When was the church built?</i>

III. Present perfect passive (Câu bị động thì hiện tại hoàn thành)

(+)	S + have/has + been + V (P.P) + (by O). <i>Ex: The letters have been sent by Tom.</i>
(-)	S + have/has + not + been + V (P.P) + (by O). <i>Ex: The project has not been completed by the team.</i>
(?)	Have/Has + S + been + V (P.P) + (by O)? <i>Ex: Has the package been delivered by the courier?</i> Wh-word + have/has + S + been + V (P.P) + (by O)? <i>Ex: Where have the keys been found by the staff?</i>

***Note:** V (P.P) = past participle: quá khứ phân từ; by O = by + đối tượng thực hiện hành động
