

How People Get Around in Different Places

People around the world use different ways to travel from one place to another. Let's learn about how they do it!

In Guatemala, people **take red buses** or **the Transmetro**. These buses help them move quickly through busy streets. You can **get on a chicken bus**. These are colorful buses that people use to go from town to town.

In places near water, people often **ride boats** or **take a ferry** to cross lakes or rivers. If you visit these areas, you might also need to **get on a boat** to see the beautiful sights!

Some people prefer to **ride motorcycles** or **use scooters** to move around quickly, especially in crowded cities. These are small and fast!

When traveling long distances, people **take planes** to fly from one country to another. You need to **get on a plane** at the airport and fly high in the sky.


In some countries, like Thailand and India, people use small taxis called **tuk-tuks**. You can **take a tuk-tuk** for a fun and fast ride!
