Positive	S + to be + P.P + (by O)	<i>Ex: Oxygen is released into the air.</i>
Negative	S + to be + not + P.P + (by O)	<i>Ex: This house is not cleaned by my brother.</i>
Question	To be + S + P.P + (by O)? Wh- + to be + S + P.P + (by O)?	<i>Ex: Is the rabbit walked by Mr. James?</i> <i>Where is the party held by your friend?</i>

II. Past Simple Passive (Bị động ở thì quá khứ đơn)

- Cách dùng: Để đề cập đến điều gì đó **được thực hiện bởi ai đó**, cái gì trong quá khứ.

- Cấu trúc:

Positive	S + was / were + P.P + (by O)	<i>Ex: The mistakes were corrected by the teacher.</i>
Negative	S + was / were + not + P.P + (by O)	<i>Ex: The wallet was not given by him.</i>
Question	Was / Were + S + P.P + (by O)? Wh- + was / were + S + P.P + (by O)?	<i>Ex: Were all the candies sold by the boy?</i> <i>When was the church built?</i>

*Note: P.P = past participle: quá khứ phân từ; O = Object: tân ngữ
