

PAST CONTINUOUS FOR INTERRUPTED ACTIONS

DAILY ROUTINES

We use **Past Continuous** with the **Simple past** when a **long action** is interrupted by a **short action**.

We use the word **when** to link the two actions.

GUIDE: Subject + was/were + verb-ing (long action in past continuous) + (object) + **when** + subject + verb (short action in past simple)

- (7) We (play) soccer outside when it (start) to storm.
- (8) John (ride) his bike when he (hear) a dog bark.
- (9) Mom (make) dinner when dad (come) home from work.
- (10) We (eat) dinner when my grandpa (visit) us.
