	STRUCTURE	EXAMPLES
AFFIRMATIVE	Sujeto + was / were + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)	When I saw them they were sitting at a café. Cuando les vi estaban sentados en una cafetería.
NEGATIVE	Sujeto + was / were + not + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)	What did you say? I wasn't listening . (tú) ¿Qué has dicho? No estaba escuchando .
INTERROGATIVE	Was / Were + sujeto + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)?	What were you talking about? (tú) ¿De qué estabas hablando?
