B1: YOU ARE READY TO DO A PERFECT MEDIATION!!!

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Mediation task B1. You're going to work in pairs, as **science teachers**. Your **13-year students are going to the chemistry lab for the first time** and your task is to **tell them how to behave in a lab**.

Teacher A is going to prepare a short message (2 minutes max.) regarding the **DO'S in a lab** and **Teacher B** about the **DON'TS in a lab**. When you're ready, record a joint audio (4 minutes max.)

Remember:

Teacher A should also be in charge of the **initial greeting and the introduction to the topic** (safety rules in the chemistry lab)

Teacher B should also be in charge of the **wrapping up and the final greeting**.

Science Lab SAFETY RULES



ALWAYS:

- * Follow all instructions given by the teacher.
- * Wear safety goggles or protective clothing when necessary.
- * Tie back long hair, secure loose clothing, & wear closed-toed shoes.
- * Report accidents, injuries & spills immediately.
- * Keep the lab area clean & neat.

NEVER:

- * Work in the science lab if a teacher isn't there.
- * Touch any materials until you are told to do so.
- * Play around during experiments.
- * Eat, drink, or chew gum during labs.
- * Look directly into a test tube or flask. Instead, look from the side.
- * Taste or smell the chemicals. Instead, carefully waft odors to your nose.

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Mediation task B2. You're supervisors at a pharmaceutical lab. Two new members – *Ivan* and *Olga*, from Russia – are going to join your team and your task is to inform them about basic safety precautions in the lab.

Supervisor A is going to prepare a short message (2'30" minutes max.) regarding the **DO'S in a lab** and **Supervisor B** about the **DON'TS in a lab**. When you're ready, record a joint audio (5 minutes max.)

Remember:

Supervisor A should also be in charge of the initial greeting and the introduction to the topic (safety rules in the pharmaceutical lab)

Supervisor B should also be in charge of the wrapping up and the final greeting.

Report any accident immediately.**




**There are no housekeeping services here.
