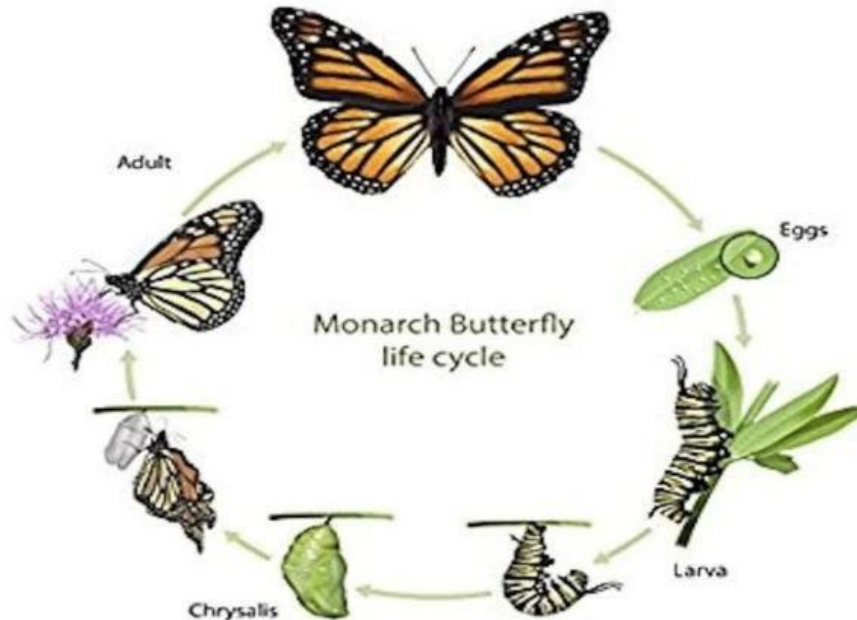


TASK 1:
