in: in the picture, just in time

on: depend on, on time, on +day/date, on the Internet

to: listen to, give birth to, go to court, matter to sb

at: bark at, at + 'public place' (e.g. at the bus stop)

of: take care of

No preposition: influence smb/ smth, miss sb, climb a mountain, discuss smth, go home, face smth etc.
