Boy: Yes, the mountain animals drink from a large  but we didn't want to do that! And it was really deep so it was a bit dangerous.





Woman: Did you all sleep in a ?


Boy: Well, you could do that. Or there was a building that you could sleep in.





Boy: Yes, some  washed all the plates after dinner but I didn't want to do that.






