


<b>This</b> – one object/person. It is close to you	<b>That</b> – one object/person. It's far from you

## PLURAL

THESE	THOSE
	
<b>These</b> – two or more objects / people. They are close to you	<b>Those</b> – two or more objects / people. They are far from you


