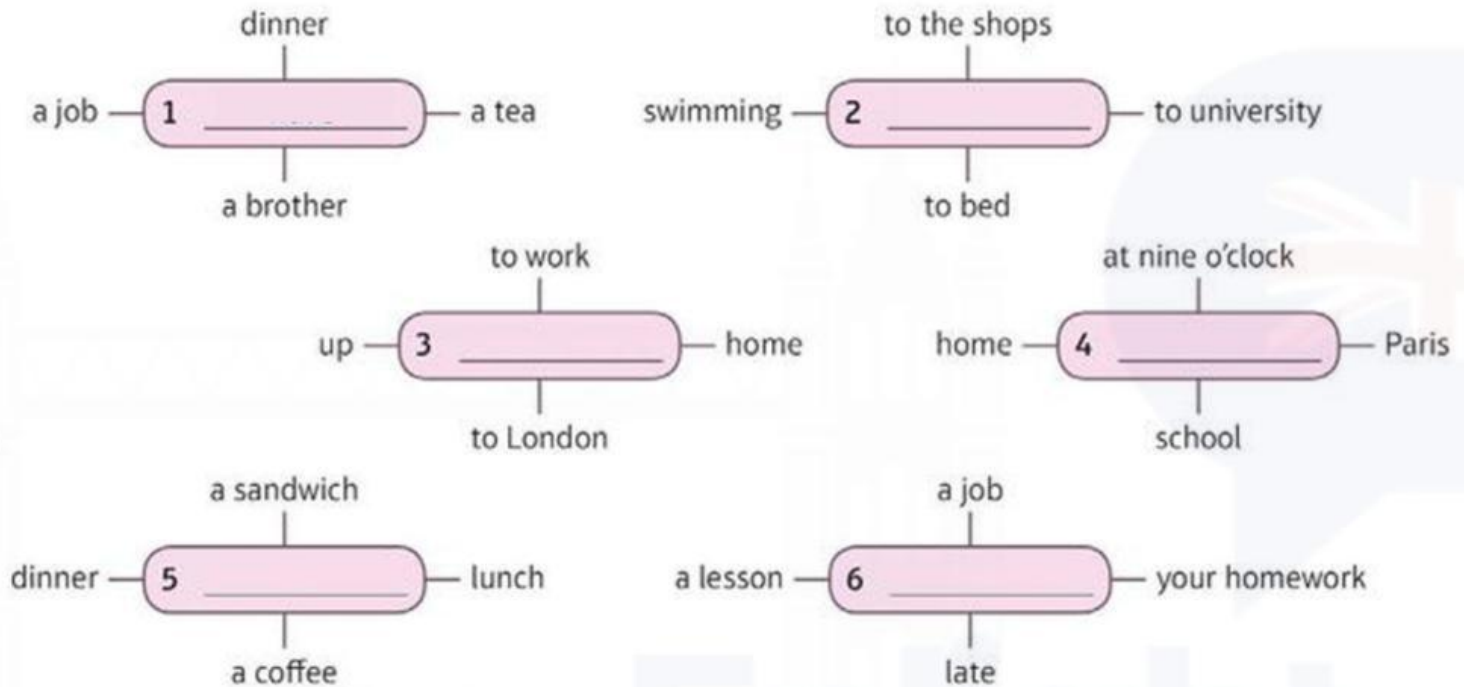


Verb phrases in routines
