

## Using the Apostrophe to Show Ownership

We add **'S** to nouns to show ownership. The **'S** goes on the name of the owner.

If the noun **ends in S** then add the **' only** .

teacher - There is no **S** on the end of this word so add **'S**

- A) teacher's                      b) teachers'

pupil**S** ← this word ends in an **S** so just add the **'**



The \_\_\_\_\_ bags are on their backs.

- a) pupil's                      b) pupils'

babies  this word ends in an S
