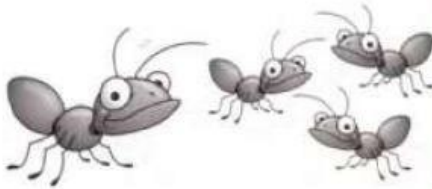


We form the plurals of most nouns by adding -s.

box	boxes
potato	potatoes

BUT: radio – radios  
piano – pianos

Nouns ending in -s, -ss, -sh, -ch, -x or -o → -es.

Nouns ending in -f or -fe by removing the -f or -fe → -ves.

Singular	Plural
leaf	leaves
knife	knives

BUT: giraffe – giraffes
