Tabin Wildlife Reserve in Sabah

The Tabin wildlife reserve is a nature and wildlife reserve that was created in 1984 to preserve Sabah's fast disappearing wildlife. The reserve is a rectangular area of about 300,000 acres, situated 48 kilometers east of Lahad Datu town.

Tabin is home to a large number of animals in the untouched forests. The three largest mammals of Sabah – the Borneo pygmy elephant, Sumatran rhinoceros and tembadau – are all found within this reserve. The orang utan and proboscis monkey can also be seen here. Four species of cats and 300 bird species have been recorded in this reserve.

Tabin Wildlife Resort, the only available accommodation, was set up in 1999 along the shallow banks of the Lipad River. There are 10 river lodges and 10 hill lodges with private bathrooms and showers. Meals are served at specific times.

Among the most popular things to do in Tabin are jungle-trekking, night safari, night walk, wildlife viewing, bird-watching and rainforest education. You will be accompanied by in-house guides at the resort for walks and safaris and for wildlife and nature observation.
