

airport	αεροδρόμιο Our plane leaves at three o'clock, so we have to be at the airport at one o'clock.	
go out	βγαίνω έξω "Let's go out on Saturday afternoon." "Great idea! We should go to the lake and have a picnic"	
middle	μέση Look! That yellow car is in the middle of the street!	
corner	γωνία Turn left and you will see the shop on the corner.	
south	νότος Birds usually fly south for the winter.	
north	βορράς They will travel north because they want to visit Thessaloniki.	

east	ανατολή	In the morning, we can see the sun in the east.	
west	δύση	France is to the west of Germany.

hope	ελπίζω	I hope I do well in this test!	
suggestion	πρόταση, υπόδειξη	Can I make a suggestion? Why don't you stay at my house?	
thank someone	ευχαριστώ κάποιον	Please thank Peter for his present! I really like it!	

as much (water) as...	τόσο (νερό) όσο...	There is as much water as we need to water the flowers.	
as many (apples) as ...	τόσα (μήλα) όσα...	I have as many apples as the video said. I can make an apple cake.	
drive	οδηγώ	Lina's father drives a big orange tractor.	
trip	ταξίδι, εκδρομή	My class will go on a day trip to Knossos next week.	
bicycle, bike	ποδήλατο	Billy hopes his parents will give him a new bicycle for his birthday.	
ride a bike	κάνω ποδήλατο	Miss Maria doesn't know how to ride a bike.	
countryside	ύπαιθρος, εξοχή	There are many farms and small villages in the countryside.	
left	αριστερά	Turn at the supermarket and you will see the theatre.	
right	δεξιά	Please, turn right on Garden street and then the train station will be at the next corner.	
straight	ευθεία	Go straight on and you will arrive at the bus stop in 10 minutes.
