

### BASIC NUMBERS

How do you say/write the following numbers?

172	One hundred AND seventy two
99.99	Ninety nine POINT NINE NINE
611,222	Six hundred AND eleven thousand, two hundred AND twenty two
3,074,345	Three million, seventy four thousand, three hundred AND forty five

**Notice** how AND always comes after HUNDRED

**Notice** that in numbers we say POINT (not dot) and that the numbers after it are always read individually.

**Notice** how the comma (,) represents the thousand position.

### YEARS

How do you pronounce these years? Usually we simply split years in to two numbers  
eg. 1976 = 19/76, but as usual in English, it doesn't always work like that.

1976	Nineteen seventy six
2014	Two thousand and fourteen/Twenty fourteen
1901	Nineteen 'oh' one
983	Nine hundred and eighty three
2101	Twenty one 'oh' one

**Notice** how it would be too long to say 'Two thousand, one hundred and one'
