Types of computer	Notes
Mainframes	✓ Large, powerful, expensive. ✓ Multi-user systems – used by many people at the same time. ✓ Used for processing very large amounts of data. ✓ The most powerful mainframes are called <i>supercomputers</i>.
Minicomputers	✓ Used like mainframes. ✓ Not as big, powerful, or expensive as mainframes. ✓ Less common now because microcomputers have improved.
Microcomputers / Personal computers (PC)	✓ The most common type of computers. ✓ Smaller, cheaper, and less powerful than mainframes and minicomputers.
Types of portable: Laptop	✓ About the size of a small typewriter. ✓ Less common now because smaller and lighter portables are available.
Notebook	✓ About the size of a piece of writing paper. ✓ The most common type of portable.
Subnotebook	✓ Not quite as big as notebook. Can fit into a jacket pocket.
Handheld / Palmtop	✓ Small enough to fit into the palm of one

	hand. ✓ Not easy to type with because of their size. ✓ Often used as personal organizers.
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
