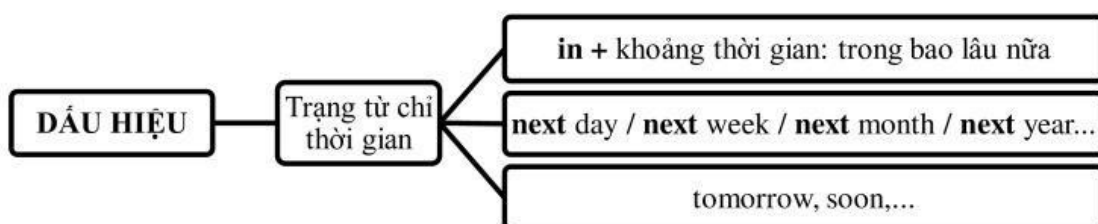
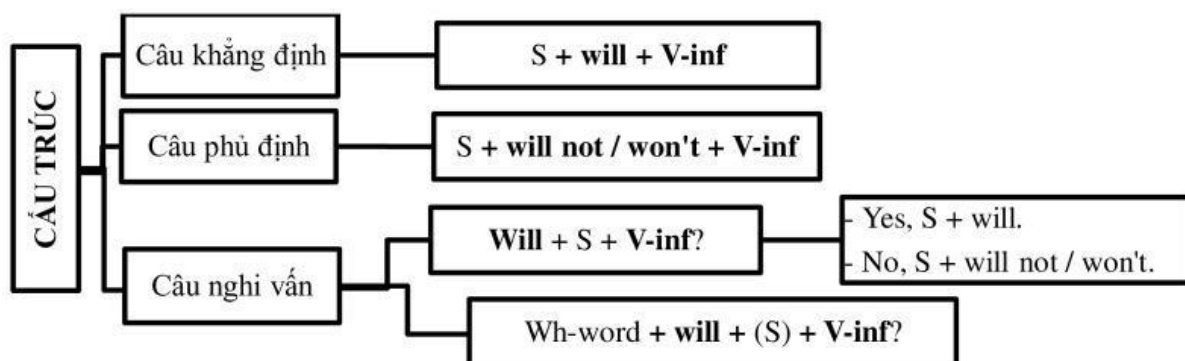

1. Will for future predictions (Thì tương lai đơn dự đoán về tương lai)

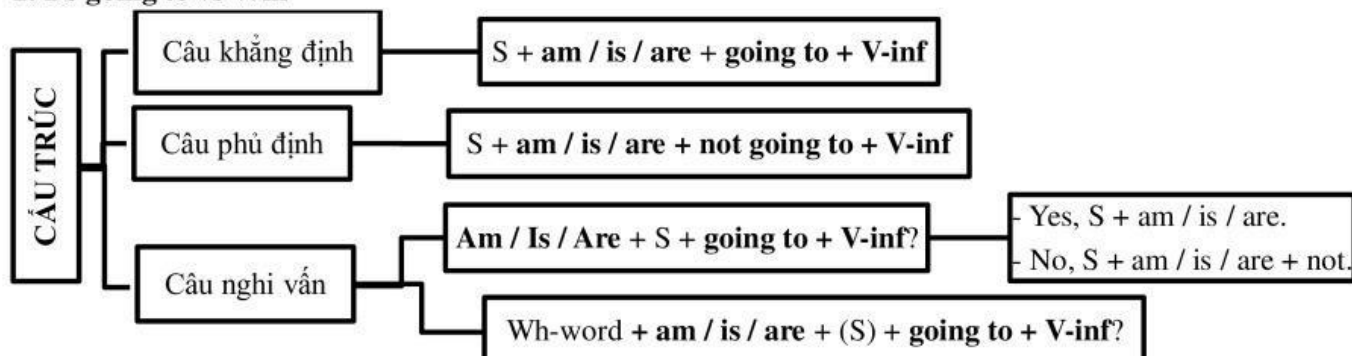
- Thì tương lai đơn dùng để đưa ra những **dự đoán không có căn cứ**. Những lời dự đoán này có thể sẽ xảy ra trong tương lai, nhưng chưa có căn cứ xác minh điều đó có thành sự thật hay không.

Ex: In 2100, people **will** use flying vehicles instead of cars. (Vào năm 2100, con người sẽ sử dụng phương tiện bay thay vì ô tô.)



***Note:** V-inf = Verb infinitive: Động từ nguyên mẫu; will = 'll

Will	Be going to
- Hành động/quyết định ngay tại thời điểm nói. <i>Ví dụ: I'll go to the market.</i>	- Kế hoạch/hành động đã được sắp đặt trước. <i>Ví dụ: Jenny is going to take an exam.</i>
- Dự đoán dựa trên ý kiến cá nhân. <i>Ví dụ: Tom thinks his team will win.</i>	- Dự đoán dựa trên bằng chứng thực tế. <i>Ví dụ: It's windy and cloudy. It is going to rain tomorrow.</i>

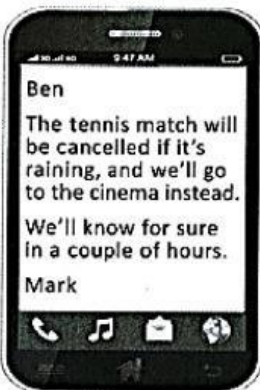

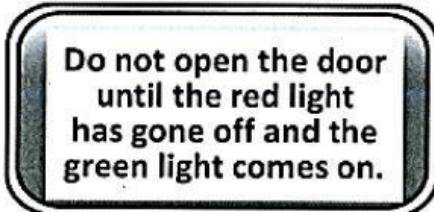
