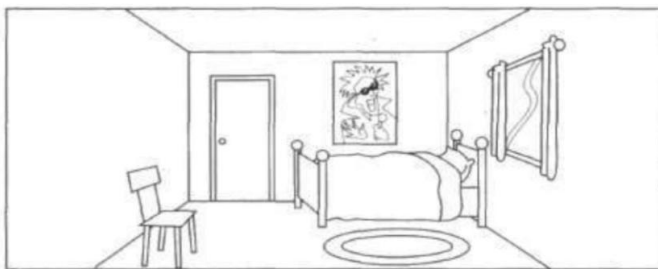
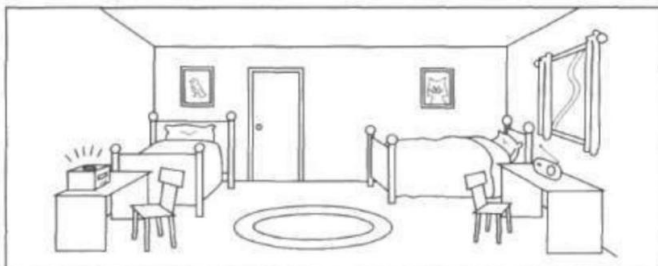


## Test 2 (Units 5–8)
