


CLIMATES OF EUROPE



MEDITERRANEAN

Temperatures are high in summer and mild in winter. Precipitation is not abundant. In fact, in summer months, there is very little rain.

POLAR

Temperatures are mild in summer and low in winter. Precipitation is abundant and regular. This climate has four seasons.

OCEANIC

Temperatures are high in summer, but very low in winter. Precipitation is higher in summer.

MOUNTAIN

Temperatures vary between -50°C in winter and 15°C in summer. Precipitation is scarce.

CONTINENTAL

Temperatures are very low in winter and cool in summer. Precipitation is abundant.
