Past Simple Yes/No questions and short answers

We use **was/were**, or the auxiliary verbs **did** and **could** + **infinitive without to** in Yes/No questions in the Past Simple.

Was Elizabeth the daughter of a French woman and Milanese man?

Did she have yellow hair and blue eyes?

In the short answer, we repeat the subject and re-use the **auxiliary verb** or **was/were**.

No, *she wasn't*.

Yes, *she did*.
