1. Bathroom etiquette (behaviors done while in a bathroom) can be different for male-bodied and female-bodied people.
2. Sometimes female-bodied people may go to the bathroom with another person.
3. Most male-bodied people go to the bathroom alone.
4. It is OK for female-bodied people to talk to a stranger while in the bathroom. They may talk while in the stall or at the sink.
5. While in a male public restroom, it is important to NOT ask any questions or have a conversation with strangers.
6. Female-bodied people use stalls and it is important to lock the door to ensure privacy.
7. Some male-bodied people use a urinal, while others use a stall. Either is OK.
8. When entering a bathroom, it is OK to pick any stall that is open.
9. When entering a bathroom, it is important to pick the urinal that is furthest away from a stranger.
10. While standing at a urinal, it is important to just unzip pants and keep pants up. Do NOT drop pants all the way to the floor.
11. It is important to not look or stare at others while standing at a urinal. This may make others uncomfortable or upset.
12. It is important to flush the toilet after using it.
13. It is important to wash hands with soap and water after using a toilet or urinal.
