It has an eagle and other symbols that show the country's history and values.



### Flag

🔊 We say pledge

It has red and white stripes and white stars on a blue background.

Each star stands for one of our states.



### Bald Eagle

🔊 It's the National **Bird**. It's on their money and the Great Seal
