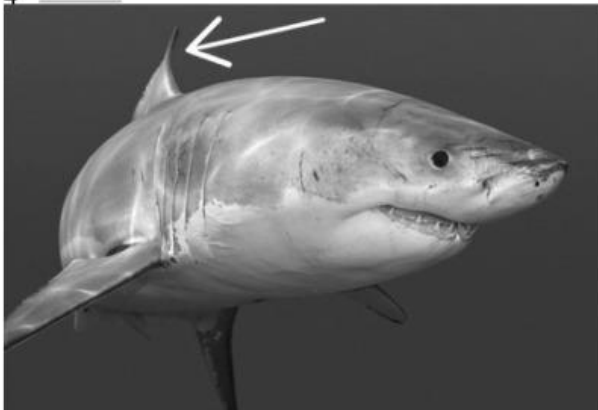

A teenager saving animals

- 1 Lou Wegner was 14 years old when he **founded** the organisation *Kids against animal cruelty*. His organisation wants more people to **adopt animals** who are in danger in animal shelters (places for lost animals or animals that people do not want).
- 2 When he started, he thought animal shelters were safe places for animals. But when he worked as a **volunteer** at one shelter, he learnt that some shelters **harm** animals. He was very sad and decided to start a social media page with articles and videos to raise awareness. He started with 47 friends in his group, and in the first two years, he helped save 20,000 animals. Now over 75,000 people follow his social media page.
- 3 Lou is an actor and always tries to find ways to raise awareness of his organisation. For example, if he's in a **public place** where there are photographers, he puts on a Kids Against Animal Cruelty T-shirt. He also filmed a music video in an animal shelter to raise awareness of the problem. The song helped raise money for the animals.
