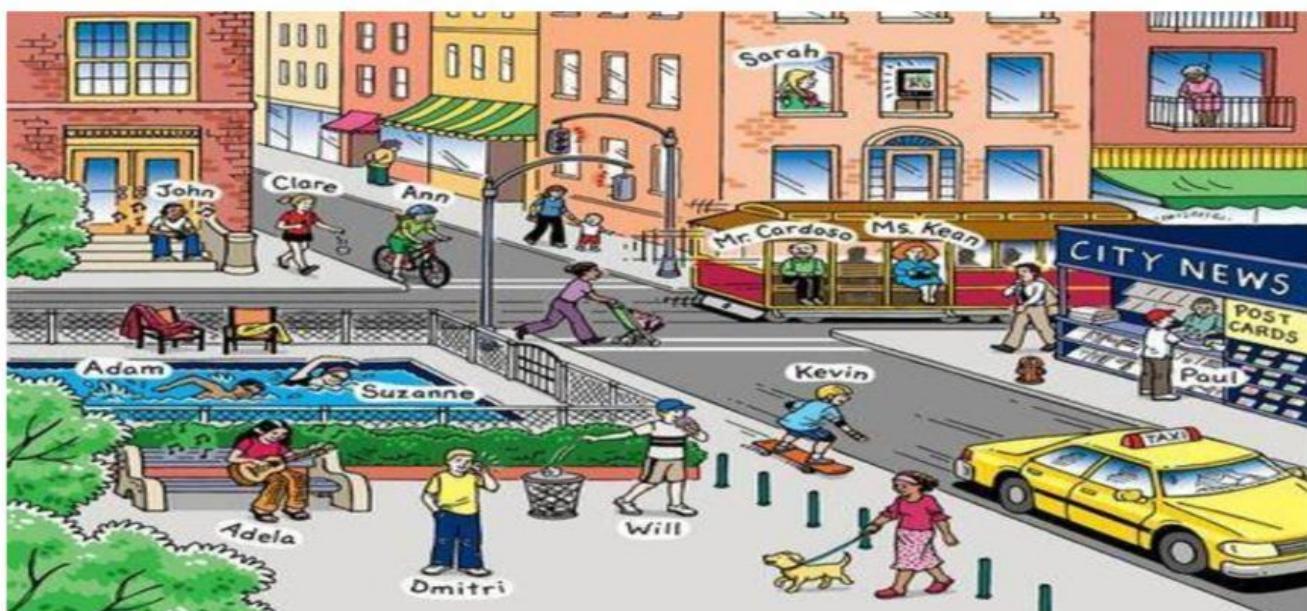

New Zealand is a country in the Pacific Ocean. Before people from Europe sailed to New Zealand, many people already lived there. They were the Maori people. The Maori sailed amazing boats to go from place to place in New Zealand. Some Maori people travelled in New Zealand. They travelled from New Zealand to live in the Chatham Islands—800 kilometers away!

The Maori people speak their own language, but before the Europeans came, they wrote stories in books. They were very good storytellers. They played music with instruments made from sea shells and performed special dances called the *haka*, the *poi*, and the *whakawatea*. They painted their faces with shapes called *moko*.
