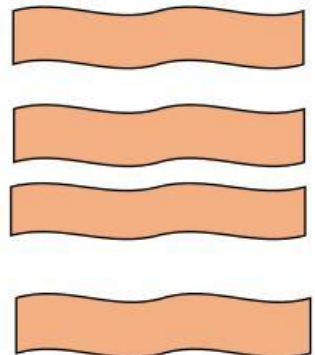
READING 1

The small tracker, called the Letter Logger, uses the GPS to store information about an item's position in transit. Similar devices have been used in the past to track expensive customer goods like cars, but until now none of these systems was small enough to travel in an envelope.

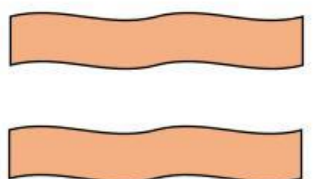

This is particularly important as the envelopes are thrown into sacks, then transported by van to automatic sorting locations where they run through high - speed shuffling systems.

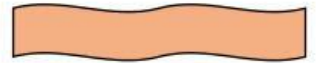
The tracker itself does not transmit its position during transit, but stores the journey log on a memory card which can be read by a laptop computer. The GPS device offers several programming options ranging from checking its position every few minutes to checking only when on the move.
